Exciting News for Affordable Rental Housing!!!

The Leon County Commission voted 6-0 at its budget workshop Tuesday, June 17 to approve new GAP funding for affordable rental housing for very and extremely low-income families!!! With funding from other state and local sources this could mean \$500,000 per year in county funding to incentivize rental development projects to benefit these families.
